

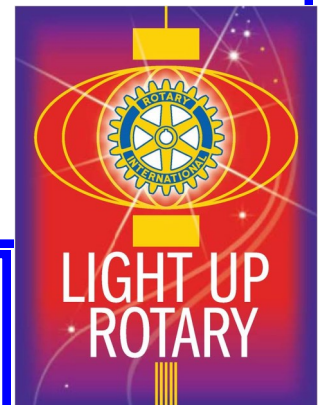
Kalori

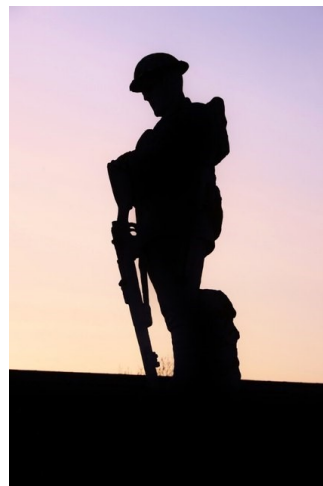

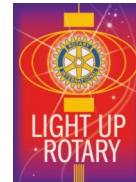
**From the Treasurer.....

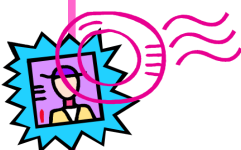
