Lida-Lotta — Exchange Student Departs

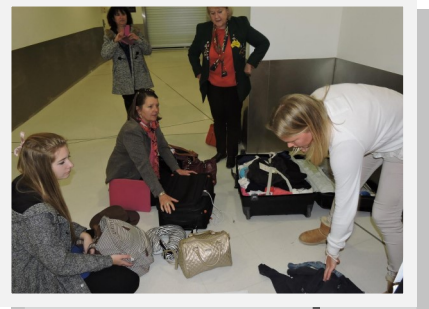
