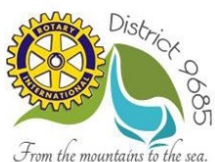


# Kalori

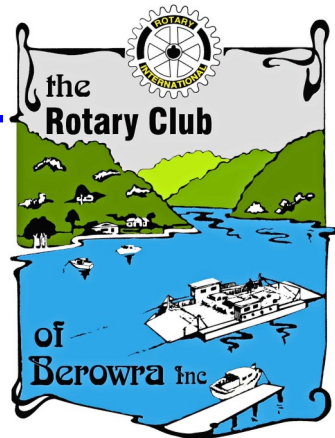
